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# AGREEMENT TO TERMS OF STUDENT INTERN PROGRAM

As a prospective participant in the J-1 Student Internship Program at Vanderbilt University, I confirm the following:

- 1. I agree to review and follow the T/IPP (DS-7002) associated with this internship;
- 2. I am entering into this Exchange Visitor (EV) Program in order to participate as a J-1 Student Intern, and not to simply engage in labor or work in the United States;
- 3. I understand that the intent of the EV Program is to allow me to enhance my skills and gain exposure to U.S. culture and business a way that will be useful to me when I return home upon completion of my program;
- 4. I understand that my internship will take place only at the organization listed on my T/IPP and that employment outside of my specific program activity as listed on the T/IPP (DS-7002) is restricted. I must obtain approval from my department and from ISSS before I participate in any academic or professional activity that is not a part of my program as described on the T/IPP or that takes place at any other location than the site listed on the T/IPP;
- 5. I will contact ISSS at the earliest available opportunity regarding any concerns, changes in, or deviations from the T/IPP;
- 6. I will respond in a timely way to all inquiries and monitoring activities;
- 7. I will follow all of my sponsor's guidelines required for my participation in the program;
- 8. I understand that my internship supervisor will evaluate my progress at the end of the internship program. If the internship is longer than 6 months, I will also be evaluated at the mid-point of the program.
- 9. I will contact the U.S. Department of State's Bureau of Educational Cultural Affairs (ECA) at the earliest possible opportunity if I believe that my sponsor or supervisor, is not providing me with a legitimate internship as delineated on my T/IPP;
- 10. I am currently enrolled in and pursuing a postsecondary degree at an academic institution outside of the United States;
- 11. I am in good academic standing at my current institution;
- 12. The internship that I am accepting will assist me in fulfilling my educational objectives and/or requirements for the completion of my academic degree:
- 13. I understand that the federal regulations do not allow the internship to last longer than 12 months.
- 14. I agree to return to my home institution at the conclusion of my internship program in order to fulfill my educational requirements. I have no intention of remaining in the U.S. at the conclusion of my internship;
- 15. I agree to make progress toward completion of my internship goals throughout the duration of the program.
- 16. U.S. government regulations require that all participants in J-1 exchange visitor status (and J-2 dependents) purchase adequate health insurance as defined by the Department of State. I will submit the J-1 Health Insurance Pledge within 15 days of the start of my J program.

#### Note about DS-2019 and T/IPP

ISSS will complete the DS-7002 Training/Internship Placement Plan (T/IPP) and a copy will be sent to you and your supervisor for review. Please notify your host department administrative contact if corrections are needed. If all is correct, both of you will need to sign and send a scan of your signature page to the host department administrative contact. Once the copies your signature pages have been forwarded to ISSS we will complete the DS-2019 and send that form along with the T/IPP to your sponsoring department. The T/IPP will contain the ISSS advisor's original signature. The department will insert your supervisor's original signature page and ship both the DS-2019 and T/IPP forms to you. You will need to sign the DS-2019 and replace the blank signature page in the T/IPP with your original signed T/IPP page before your visa interview. We recommend you make a copy of the signed DS-2019 and T/IPP forms before your visa interview to keep for your records.

### **DEPENDENTS**

PLEASE PROVIDE ALL OF THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION FOR EACH FAMILY MEMBER THAT WILL ACCOMPANY YOU TO U.S. ON J-2 (DEPENDENT) VISAS. TO QUALIFY FOR J-2 VISAS, THE INDIVIDUAL MUST BE YOUR SPOUSE OR UNMARRIED CHILD (UNDER 21 YEARS OLD).

Note: Prospective J-1 scholars must show a minimum of \$30,000 per year for themselves and an additional \$6,000 for each dependent, in order for the DS-201 to be issued.
